Peter gave her his hand and lifted her up; then called the saints and widows in to see that she was alive.

Peter obeyed God and went with the three men to Cornelius' home. Cornelius gathered his family and close friends to hear Peter and while Peter was preaching, the Holy Ghost fell on all of them which heard the word and they spoke with tongues and magnified God. After they received the Holy Ghost, Peter baptized all of them with water. (Acts 10:1-48)
